[1] The IDT Energy SmartFlex rate is the per unit rate that will apply to the first monthly billing cycle only. Thereafter, IDT's standard variable rates will apply. Rates are only available to new IDT customers enrolling between 2/1/25 and 2/28/25 unless otherwise specified. This is a variable rate product. The rate for the electricity and/or natural gas supplied will fluctuate at IDT's discretion based on numerous factors as explained in the Terms & Conditions. IDT may change the rate without notice and the rate may be higher or lower than the utility's rate in any particular month. There is no cap on the rate. Savings are neither implied nor guaranteed. [2] To take advantage of the "IDT SmartBudget Locked Rate" program above customers must enroll between 2/1/25 and 2/28/25. This promotion is not available to current IDT supply customers unless otherwise specified. As an IDT SmartBudget Rate Guarantee customer, your electricity and/or natural gas supply rate will be guaranteed to remain at the respective rates above per kWh/therm for the initial number of monthly billing cycles indicated. [3] The Renewable/Green Electricity supply product is matched 100% with renewable energy certificates (RECs). If you choose IDT's Carbon Offset Gas option, IDT will purchase carbon offsets and/or carbon credits to match 100% of your natural gas consumption. [4] There are no termination fees applicable to SmartFlex Variable-rate plans. SmartBudget fixed electricity and/or natural gas supply rates will be guaranteed to remain locked for the rate per kWh/therm mentioned above for the monthly billing cycles indicated. There is no termination fee in IL, IN, MD, DC, OH, NJ, and PA if customer chooses to terminate service prior to the expiration of the initial term, customer will be obligated to pay an early termination fee of \$10.00 for their monthly billing cycle, or portion thereof, remaining in the initial term. In NY the ETF will be no greater than \$100 for the remaining term, is less than 12 monthly billing cycles, and \$200 if the remaining term is 12 monthly billing cycles or more. [5] IDT is not the same entity as your electric delivery company. You are not required to enroll with IDT. Through 5/31/25, the ComEd electric supply price to compare is \$0.0647 per kWh. Ameren is \$0.0809 or \$0.0809 & >800 kWh \$0.07506 per kWh. The electric supply price to compare does not include the purchased electricity adjustment factor. [6] In NY, IDT, traditional electric and natural gas supply is offered bundled with Home Protection plans provided by Cinch Home Services, Inc. Refer to your Terms & Conditions for details regarding these programs. [8] In select OH areas & ComEd IL, your rates for Green Variable, Traditional Fixed & Green Fixed electricity supply will initially be set at the rates above per kWh. You will also pay a Daily Service Fee of up to \$0.24 per kWh. In Ameren IL, there is a monthly service fee of up to \$6.99 per month. Your supply service will start when the utility company approves your IDT Energy enrollment, which should be in approximately 15 - 45 days, depending on your next meter reading & it will continue on a month-to-month basis until either party terminates it. [9] MD customers participating in an energy assistance program are not eligible for enrollment in these products. [*] IDT is not your local utility company. We are an independent energy supplier. You are not required to switch to an independent supplier.
